
### **Travel arrangements**

Participants have to make their travel arrangements themselves, at own cost.

HAFL is well accessible by train and urban railway. The main international airports are Geneva, Zurich and Basle. By train it may take you one to one and a half hours to Bern train station in any case.

# **Meeting location**

From the city centre the easiest transportation means is the Metro. HAFL is served by one Metro station called "Oberzollikofen", line S8 (see map below).





Exit the train station in eastern direction, walk downstairs and turn left. After 20 m turn right, cross the street via pedestrian crossing and go straight in eastern direction until you get to the HAFL (Division of Bern University of Applied Sciences). This walk will take you around ten minutes (see map on the left side).
